**On Some Forms Characteristic of the Oral Speech in the Language
of "Georgian Law Monuments"**

SUMMARY

It has been known that the Georgian language of the transitional period is characterized with the coexistence of old and new forms in the analysed material ("Georgian Law Monuments", I, 1957), which belongs to the beginning of the 18 th century, due to its specific nature, forms characteristic of colloquial speech prevail.

Different types of dialectisms, on the one hand, and the grammatical forms and word combinations, that must have been characteristic of colloquial speech, have been presented in the article.
