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Towards Some Aspects of Self-separation of Speech Codes

Summary

It has been mentioned in the scholarly literature that there exist the tendency of dialect self-separation, through which a dialect, despite of the impact of a literary language and the influence of adjacent dialects, retains its originality.

The proces of self-separation implies the perception and the understauding of the peculiarities of the native and adjacent codes by a code-carrier.

The article is an attempt to reveal and explain some of the mechanisms of self-separation.
