**Contact of Existant Forms of Language in One Linguatic Situation**

Summary

From the sociolinguistic point of view language contacts have been discussed in the light of modelling of linguistic situations.

The sociolinguistic specialist literature presents several attempts of modelling of linguistic situations. Though in our case, when discussing the data of the small Russian-Georgian-speaking group living in Kutaisi, E. Tumanian's model has been taken as a basis.

After Georgia became independent, the Georgian language was granted a social basis to broaden the spheres of functioning, and the languages of non-native population retained their colloquial form. Such Languages became in-group vernaculars.
