

**One More Coefficient in the Sociolinguistic Model of the Role Relations**

Summary

The study of empirical materials prove that the existed sociolinguistic formulae of role relations are not universal for any situation. Therefore, a corresponding coefficient should be added to a formula. As a result of the study of speech acts in K. Gamsakhurdia's 'Kidnapping of the Moon', it became clear that for certain speech acts, which are expected to be formulated as  $R_x=R_y$  (the roles of communicator are equal), the traditional formula is not sufficient. In the sociological theory of roles the factor of role-strain has been identified. Hence, I introduce the coefficient S in order to accomplish the above given formula:

S

$R_x=R_y,$

where S designates the role-strain between the communicators.
