Nation, Language and Philosophical Anthropology

Summary

It is impossible to prove the necessity of the human interrelation among nations without the ethical and philosophical foundation of the concept of nation with the help of mother tongue. It must be mentioned that such an understanding of the concept of nation should precede the understanding of the concept of a human, i. e. comparative ethnophilosophy should be an introduction to philosophical anthropology, and comparative ethnophilosophy, in its turn, should be based on such comparative linguistics, for which any language, first of all, is a worldview (and not only a means of communication).
