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ETYMOLOGICAL INVESTIGATIONS. *TROBA* ("BECOMING DRUNK")

Troba in the old and modern Georgian means to become drunk. "tr" root is traced in an other kartvelian language, in Svan. Though li-tr-e does not exactly mean to become drunk, it means to *d/r/i/n/k*. The word *troba* also has the meaning to become wet, to drench. Persian *tar* also means *wet*. The verb *tar* Kardan *to make wet* is derived from the same root.

We suppose that the discussed lexical units of the Georgian and Persian languages have the common source of origin.
