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DIALECT, ETHNOGRAPHY AND FOLKLORE ASPECTS OF PHRASEOLOGY

Phraseological peculiarities of a language (a dialect) is in direct relationship with the artistic thinking and the characteristic features of the patterns of imagination of the corresponding speech community. The features of different dialect groups contributing to particular traits of phraseological units are conditioned by various factors such as: natural environment, husbandry, farming, and traditions, beliefs, rites, ethic and esthetic views, and also some other aspects of the values of communities.
