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ON THE ORIGIN OF THE STEM TERDZ IN GEORGIAN

- Words with **terdz** stems are found in Georgian with activities related to **ploughing**;
- The same word means “someone who sews man’s clothes.” I think that the words have different origin. **Terdz** related to ploughing should have come from the Persian **dazz** meaning “creak”, “cut” and **terz** for the man’s clothe maker should be the later borrowing from Turkish **terzi**.
