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“LAGWIZ DABÄR”

In the villages of Latali and Lenjeri. (Upper Svaneti), apart from the **icon** (religious) farming there was a practice of offering lands to the God. called **Laguiz // Laguz**, People made sacred flour from the crop taken from such fields. Only a part of population possessed sacrificed lands of the Kind. As different from the fields offered to the Lord as the “common” land (“Latskhat”) Lagwiz// Laguz fields continued to remain privately owned. In modern times this tradition of offering arable lands to God is no longer in practice
