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THE IMPLICATIVE SUPER – PHRASAL UNITIES OF CONDITIONAL SEMANTICS (ON THE BASIS OF ENGLISH AND GEORGIAN LANGUAGES)

The represented paper aims at studying the implicative super – phrasal unities of conditional semantics on the basis of English and Georgian Languages. We pay our special attention to expressing the conditional meaning when researching the super phrasal unities.

On the first stage of the research formal implicatures, especially elliptical sentences and incomplete constructions supposed to be the regular markers of implicative condition, are studied.

Further, there are also discussed the occasional types of sentences, as they express the implicit conditional meaning of occasional character, are created only in certain context and are not fixed on a regular basis of usage.

The research proved that the implicature is expressed through the ellipsis, incomplete constructions and so-called occasional types of sentences in English and Georgian languages. Besides there are some constructions actualizing the sub-contextual semantics of the condition, though their surface syntactic expressions are absolutely different from each other.
