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ON THE QUESTION OF THE SEMANTIC CLASS-CATEGORY PREFIXES - B-//BU-//BI-//BA-//BO- IN A CERTAIN GROUP OF WORDS OF THE KARTVELIAN DIALECTS

1. The paper discusses phonetic dialectal variants of nouns denoting *fly, ant, bee, moth, mosquito, spider* and other nouns of the same entomological groups in comparison with the corresponding lexical units of other Ibero-Caucasian languages. I have also considered Turkish and Persian borrowings. Here, I give the motivation of nominating the objects carry out analysis in consideration of different vernaculars and speeches, coincidence of semantic structures and prefixes, semantic change and expansion / unification cases.

2. Having analyzed considerable amount of materials - I have drawn the conclusion that lingual data of Kartvelian languages are in close relationship with the mountain region sub-dialects and speeches. The only difference in class-category mark realization is revealed in signifying the primary function of the suffixes conveying *smallness* that later obtained the function to express the meaning of "flight".
