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**ON SOME QUESTIONS OF DERIVATION OF NAMES OF  
PROFESSION OF ARABIC ORIGIN IN GEORGIA**

Some languages make use of special affixes to derive the names related to artisanship or other skilled work. The Georgian language uses prefixial-suffixal derivation, which can be added to the Georgian roots or to foreign roots. Arabic is among them.

The paper provides semantic formal analysis of the words derived through the noted way of formation (such as, me-lursm-e, me-mashkhal-e; me-magaro-e, me-qalib-e).
