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**ON THE POSTPOSITION CASE FORMS IN THE  
MODERN ZAN DIALECTS**

In Kartvelian dialects, similar to the literary Georgian, postpositions fall into the two types:

They can be detached from the noun they follow or merged with the case forms. In Zan dialects postpositions add to the genitive or formerly genitive cases. Among the merged (with the case) postpositions we occur *kele* (= to, towards), *gura*, *oro* (= 'like') 'I -is' (= up to; to certain locality), 'i-h' s-ri ( in likeness)
