

## KAKHABER KEBULADZE

### SOME ISSUES OF THE 19TH CENTURY GEORGIAN HISTORY IN NIKO BERDZENISHVILI'S WRITINGS

The issues of the 19th century Georgian history have been discussed in the II and V volumes of n. berdzenishvili's "essays in the history of georgia". Although n. berdzenishvili has not specially dealt with the issues of the 19th century georgian history, his views have been displayed in his comprehensive work "Georgia in the first quarter of the 19th century", comprising 1800-1813 and ending with the story of the rebel in kakheti. In this work, further deeper investigation. these are the following issues: 1) elimination of the kingdom of kartl-kakheti and the establishment of the Russian rule; assessment of the russian rule; 2) the kingdom of imereti; 3) russia's attitude to trancaucasian political units; 4) Georgian pinches' migration to Russia; 5) the attitude of Georgian feudal and peasants to the Russian rule.

Irrespective of the fact that n. berdzenishvili's investigations were concentrated on the issues of the georgian history of the feudal times, he paid special interest to the studies of the 19th century georgian history. This has been an opponent (see n. berdzenishvili's reviews: n. makharadze "the 1819-1820 rebel half of the 19th century (before the peasant reform of 1864)", and other dissertations).
