**ON THE QUESTION OF A CERTAIN SET  
OF MEDIO-ACTIVE VERBS**

One of the types of the medio-active verbs reveal two different forms of conjugation. The verbs of the type as “tiris”, “priaiebs” make use of forms according to the model of active “tiris”-“atirebs”, the itira” or passive forms (tiris-atirdeba-itira) to sustain the completion of the incomplete paradigms.

This type of verbs can be termed as mixed or blend types.

Thus, medial voice verbs form three different groups: Medio-active, Medio-passive and Blend or Mixed groups. i.e. the groups that make use of both medio-active and medio-passive forms.
