### QUESTIONS OF BAGHDADI HISTORICAL GEOGRAPHY (According to the data of family name analysis)

Ethnological and historical study of Baghdadi family names asserts that the region took a long process of development and that it was populated in the mid-feudal and even earlier periods. In parallel with the development of the social life the historical boundaries of the Baghdadi region underwent changes.

The changes were the results affected by the different intermittent migration waves from the various Georgian communities, which, in their turn, influenced on the local rites and ways of life.

Though the family-names show the migration line to a particular reason, there are also some family-names e.g. Kbilashvili, that might have been arisen independently, without the relation to their original province.
