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ON SOME CHARACTERISTICS OF WORD-BUILDING IN IMERKHEULI DIALECT

Imerkheuli is a rich dialect with its archaic words and neologisms. This phenomenon reveals itself in word-building presenting an interesting linguistic picture. Observation on the word-building of Imerkheviian dialect has made evident the viability and resistancy of the Georgian Language. It proves that in spite of the privileged position of the Turkish language in the area for four centuries period of the dominance of Turkish (Ottoman) language and its forms, Georgian language has preserved its roots intact. Judging according to the course of events that the Imerkheviian dialect has undergone we can be hopeful that it will throw its shoots in the future and like other Georgian dialects nurture the literary Georgian language river as one of its strongest tributary.
