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BORROWINGS FROM ARABIK-PERSIAN VOCABULARY ACCORDING TO THE IOSEB GRISHASHVILI'S "KALAKURI DICTIONARY" ("CITY VOCABULARY")

We think that in the the Ioseb Grishashvili's "Kalakuri Leksikoni" the words: 1. arakati, 2. asli, 3. zarifi, 4. maslaati, 5. majama, 6. munasibi, 7. nafazi, 8. niati, 9. faida, 10. khatabala, 11. xalali, 12. jalali, 13. jumali and 14. hasari should have originated from the following Arabik-Persian lexical units: 1. حرکات (harakat), 2. اصل (asl), 3. ظریف (zarif), 4. مصلحت (maslahat), 5. مجمع (majma'), 6. مناسب (monaseb), 7. نفس (nafas), 8. نیت (niat), 9. فایده (fāide), 10. خطا - بلاء (khata - balā'), 11. حلال (halāl), 12. جلال (jalāl), 13. جمل (jomāl) and 14. حصار (hesār).
