### STALIN'S LINGUISTIC-ETHNIC POLICY AND INFORMATION SABOTAGE DANGEROUS FOR GEORGIAN NATION

Today Georgia is in the epicenter of larger geopolitical confrontations; therefore, it is essential to realize that artificial separation of Georgians linguistically and ethnically leads to disintegration of the Georgian ethnos. By taking into account the history, it is easy to understand that if new, the so-called ethnic-cultural geopolitical fluctuations (inspired and provoked by forces from outside Georgia) develop in our country, the Russian imperial forces will easily carry out further disintegration of the Georgian territory. The Russian imperial officials clearly state that they aim at Georgia's final disintegration, annexation of peripheral regions and restoration of geopolitical control in Central Caucasus.

We believe, with national government functioning in the country, there will be no opportunities to proceed with the Stalinist information Sabotage, since it is possible today to provide qualification of the Kartvelian linguistic world on the basis of historical reality and modern terminological approaches. In this case, the imperial sources will be unable to provide new Tada Ashordia, Misho Dadiani and Isak Zhvania with the relevant basis (at present, activation of forces inspired from the neighbouring empire is evident in Megrelia). For the purposes of avoiding information attacks by Russian empire it is necessary to elaborate appropriate language policy in current period; otherwise, Georgia might face adverse future prospects.
