### TRANSITIVE VERB FORMATION PECULIARITIES IN PLUPERFECT IN THE ETSERI SPEECH

In Svan dialects different types of verbs form the Pluperfect in different ways.

The formation pattern for transitive verbs in Pluperfect is as follows: Pluperfect is based on the form of Perfect to which a suffix is added in all persons and numbers, namely:

Balskvemoan *än*, Balszemoan *än*, Lashkh *ân/çn*, Lentekhian *an*.

The Lashkh dialect reveals peculiarities in conjugation of transitive verbs where auxiliary verb appears in the formation of Pluperfect which is atypical of other dialects.

Examination of the Etseri Speech revealed interesting forms of Pluperfect such as: *mi'paw-än-da* ("I had painted"), *misq-än-da* ("I had done"), etc. *-da* suffix, which is, normally, a formant of the imperfect screeve, is added to the formative marker *än*.
