ADVERB IN SHAVSHIAN

Different means are applied for expressing adverbs of place in the *Shavshian dialect* such as:

a) *dative case forms without a nominal suffix*: *zamtari bursas vart čven* and such dative case forms without nominal suffixes which lack a case marker: *ert bi i mqavs artvin*.

b) *forms with nominal suffixes*: *batumši caval*; *hohleviske cahval*.

Adverb of time with a nominal suffix: *im droši movdivart*; *dilaze dedopal gamevqvant garet*.

Adverb of time without a nominal suffix: *im ġames deipantvian*; *zamtari bursas vart čven*.

Adverbs of manner. In the *Shavshian dialect* the *adverbial case forms of nouns* are used as adverbs of manner; in these forms a consonantal part of the case marker is dropped and *y* is added: *jveleburay ar ari*; *kartulay vagineb*.

The adverb of manner with the nominal suffix *-ჰოთ* (-vit) is often represented in *-ჰეპ/-ჰენ* (-vep / -ven) form: *chvarsavep evlen*; *hesaven geizdeba*.
