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THE LEXICAL TRADITION OF THE PHYSICAL (OR SPIRITUAL) DEFECT OF THE HUMAN BEING IN GEORGIAN LANGUAGE AND MODERNITY

Georgian language has a lot direct (sharp) phraseology that marks the shortcomings and vices of humankind and it is confirmed in ancient Georgian writings as well. Today this traditional approach is replaced by the international terminology, the majority of which are either borrowed or coppeid phrases. In Georgian, as in language of great tradition of statehood, the etiquette of speech taking care of human dignity is clearly visible and it should be taken into consideration.
