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THE FEATURES OF WORDS' SYNTACTIC RELATION
IN GEORGIAN

The article "The features of Words' Syntactic Relation in Georgian" refers to understanding of the various types of word connections and attempts to provide the classification of syntagmas in Georgian. One of the objectives of the Syntax is to find out the relation between components of syntagmas. Difference in views that exists concerning the types of words' syntactic relationship in Georgian scholarly literature has led us to get involved in the study of the issue.

The following cases have been discussed: 1) Whether or not the relation between noun and verb is considered as agreement; 2) whether such types of syntagmas as *zpv is qali-* ("sea water") are considered as case government or agreement; 3) whether or not nouns with prepositions *-ze, -ši, -ken* are governed.

The attempt of classification of syntagmas is also proposed. The attention is focused on the issues which cause the peculiarity of components of syntagma in Georgian.

The creation of valency list of Georgian verbs the syntactic ability of which we take into consideration, and the preparation of word combination vocabulary will not only assist a learner of the Georgian language but will simplify the machine translation.
